WINTER TAX EXPLANATION / LOOKING AT YOUR TAX BILL

<u>Winter Taxes:</u> Winter taxes are mailed out the end of November and payable December 1 through February 28 without penalty. Winter taxes are subject to a 1% penalty and 4% administration fee to the Macomb County on payments received after February 28th and payable to Macomb County Treasurer.

Bruce Township Operating: Funds for the day-to-day operations of the Township.

Library: Millage provides funding for the operations of the Romeo District Library.

<u>Parks and Rec:</u> Millage provides funding for the operations of the Romeo, Washington, Bruce Parks and Recreation.

Star (Senior Transportation): Millage provides funding for the transportation of our local senior citizens.

<u>Veterans:</u> Funds are used to aid Macomb County Veterans, which was passed at the regular election on November 4, 2008.

Zoo Authority: Funds are used to cover expenses of the Detroit Zoo, which voters approved at the primary election on August 5, 2008.

DIA: Funds are used to fund the Detroit Institute of Arts. Voters approved this millage on November 6, 2012.

SMART Bus: Funds are for Suburban Mobility Authority for Regional Transportation. This service provides curb-to-curb pick-up with advance notification and is open to the general public, Approved by voters I August 2006.

<u>Huron-Clinton Metro Authority (HCMA):</u> Funds provide Huron Clinton Metropolitan Authority with resources for capital improvements and operation of county parks. This is Public Act 147 of 1939 passed in November 1940.

<u>Macomb Med Care: (Martha T. Berry)</u> The facility was established in 1949 and is one of 35 county medical care facilities in Michigan that care for medically frail seniors despite their ability to pay.

<u>Bruce Township Fire and Advance Life Support:</u> For the day-to-day operation services as provided by Bruce Township Fire Department voter approved at 5 Mills and levied at 2.24. ALS (Advance Life Support) voter approved at 5 Mills and levied at 3.29.

<u>Administrative Fee:</u> Property tax administration fee is defined as a fee to offset costs incurred by a collecting unit in assessing property values, in collecting the property tax levies, and in the review and appeal processes.
